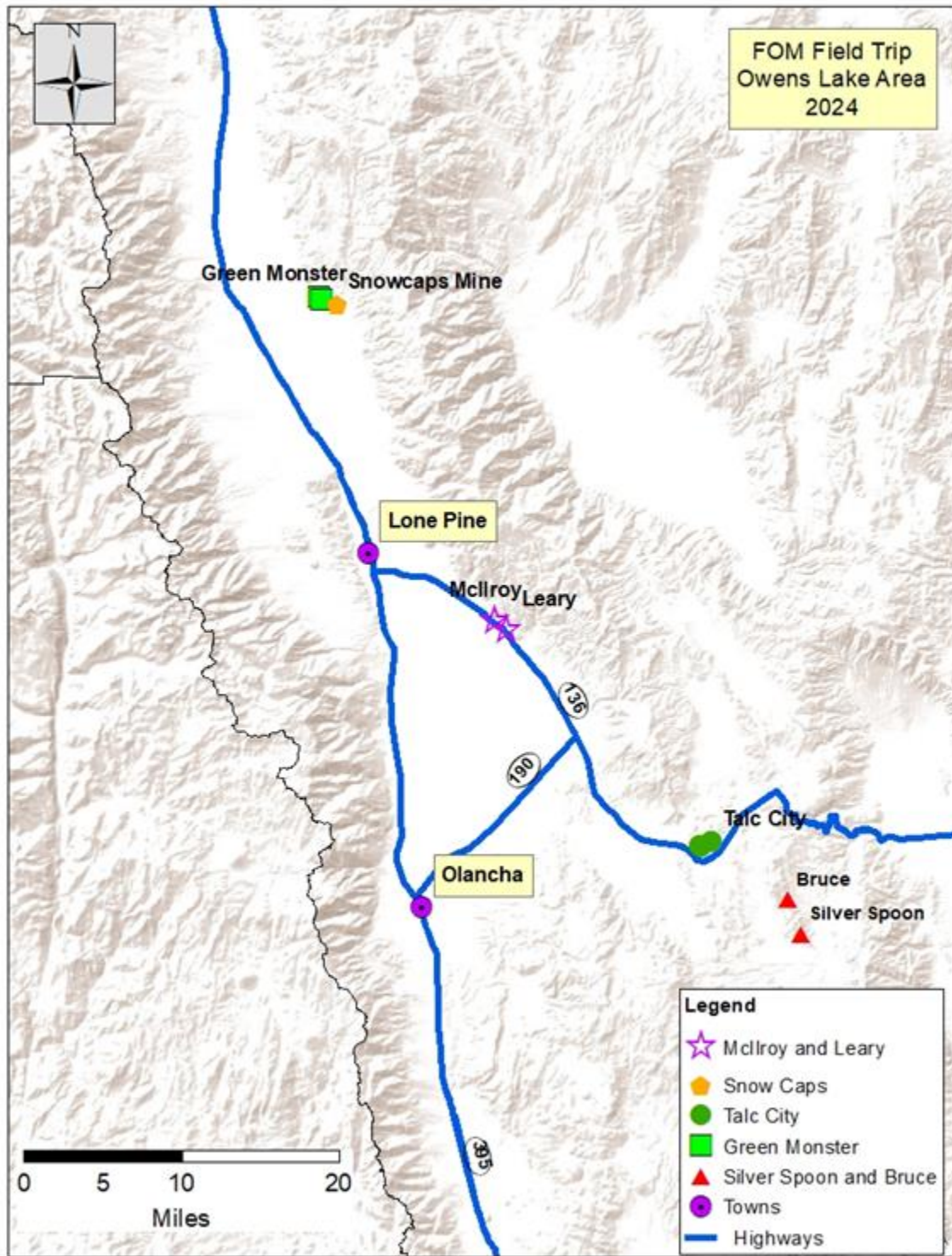
11:50am to 12:15pm – All three speakers will discuss Saturday afternoon and Sunday field trip logistics.
